The Energy Bill 2023 made Ofgem the official regulator for heat networks, introducing new rules to protect consumers and improve efficiency. The Heat Network Market Framework will cover zoning policies, the Heat Network Technical Assurance Scheme (HNTAS), and consumer protection regulations. Together, these changes aim to ensure fair treatment and more reliable, sustainable heat networks across the UK, benefiting consumers, heat suppliers, and the environment.

Heat Network Zoning

Zoning will help speed up the roll-out of heat networks by identifying areas where they're the most cost-effective way to cut carbon from heating. This gives local areas a head start in planning and building greener, cheaper heat.

Heat Network Technical Assurance Scheme

This new scheme will set basic performance standards for how heat networks are designed, built, and run, helping to make them more efficient, reliable, and better for everyone using them.
