What is an energy tariff

An energy tariff refers to the pricing structure associated with the energy you consume, typically comprising of two main elements:

- **Unit rate:** the cost per kilowatt-hour (kWh) of energy used.
- **Daily standing charge:** a fixed fee covering the operational costs of maintaining the energy supply and heat network.

Why we can't provide your tariff breakdown

Whilst we strive to offer transparency in the energy tariffs we calculate and set, there are instances where we don't have a breakdown of your specific tariff. This occurs when the **heat supplier has calculated the tariff independently, without our involvement or provision of details.**
